

HOT V Auction of Mistral 16 Sailboat

This Mistral 16, donated by Jack Davidson, will be auctioned off to benefit Earlier.org.

Built in Canada with the same hull shape as the Wayfarer, with similar performance. Two watertight doors forward open into a generous storage compartment. There is a covered aft storage compartment with a drain. 365 lbs. displacement with 141 sq. ft. sail area.

Gelcoat on hull, deck, and cockpit has faded but is in good condition. Rudder and centerboard are in good condition, with a new tiller custom made by Phil Leonard. Standing and running rigging are in good condition. Sails (main and genoa) are good, with some rust staining. Mainsail has reef points.

She has blocks and cleats for a spinnaker but does not have a spinnaker or rigging.

Trailer is cosmetically fair but is sound, with new springs, new bearings, and good tires. Boat and trailer have good titles. This is a great boat to enjoy sailing with the whole family. She has been gone over and is in sailaway condition.

This boat will be available for inspection at the lake starting Sept. 24th.

2016 Tanzer 16 Nationals

In 2015, Lake Townsend hosted the Tanzer 16 nationals for the first time. The Tanzer Association members enjoyed the venue so much that the Tanzers returned this year—perhaps in hopes of better winds than last year.

Alas, it was not to be. Saturday's winds were light and extremely shifty, even for Lake Townsend. PRO Eric Rasmussen somehow managed to get in three races after having to move the marks and pin multiple times before each race. In spite of that, in Race 2 the windward mark boat was treated to the sight of a fleet of Tanzers coming wing-and-wing straight downwind as they approached the mark!

In spite of the light air, competition was fierce, with the boats rounding the windward mark within seconds of each other. Light, shifty winds are a test of boat control, with little margin for error.

Sunday's forecast was for calm conditions. In spite of that the fleet launched, perhaps in hopes of a repeat of last year when the wind freshened nicely for the Sunday races, but after repeated puffs that lured the race committee boats from place to place only to disappear, Eric called to abandon.

But no-one went hungry! Saturday evening there was a sumptuous array of hot and cold Mediterranean food courtesy of the Tanzer Association, and Sunday there were still-delicious leftovers.

On Saturday evening Association president Arch Altman presented the race committee with classy engraved Tanzer bailers (which work great for adult beverages). After lunch Sunday it was time to award the winners with equally classy engraved glass trophies and highball glasses. LTYC's Wendell Gundlach and Nancy Collins brought home silver in Tanzer 6, sail number 2003, sailing against seasoned, long-time Tanzer sailors.




