NOTICE OF RACE

1. RULES

1.1 The Regatta will be governed by the rules as defined in *The Racing Rules of Sailing*.

2. SAILING INSTRUCTIONS

2.1 The Sailing Instructions will be posted on the Lake Townsend Yacht Club (LTYC) website by Sept 24, 2021 at <http://laketownsendyachtclub.com>. Please print and bring your own copy. Hardcopies of the Sailing Instructions will not be available at the venue.

2.2 The Sailing Instructions will be posted on the official notice board for taking photos with phones.

3. COMMUNICATION

3.1 The official notice board is located on the east side of the LTYC equipment shed.

4. ELIGIBILITY AND ENTRY

4.1 All classes of sailboats with active US Sailing Portsmouth numbers are invited to compete.

4.2 Eligible boats may enter by completing the online entry form [here](#).

4.3 Eligible boats may enter by completing the attached entry form.

4.4 Registration closes at 1800 on September 24. There will be no onsite registration.

4.5 To be considered an entry in the event, a boat shall complete all registration requirements and pay all fees.

5. FEES

5.1 See table on Mayor's Cup Entry Form (last page)

6. SCHEDULE

Friday, September 24

1300 Tune-up sailing. Check in at the marina office before launching. Launch fees are in effect for sailing on Friday. Boats may be rigged and left overnight, just notify marina office of name and phone number if left overnight.

Saturday, September 25

1130 1st Warning signal. Two races to follow.

Sunday, September 26

1030 1st Warning signal. One race to follow.

No warning signal will be made after 1430.

7. VENUE

7.1 Lake Townsend Marina: 6332 Townsend Rd., Brown Summit, NC 27214. The race course will be set south of the boat launch.

8. COURSES

8.1 Courses to be sailed will be windward/leeward with four or six legs. The target time for races is 45 minutes.

9. SCORING

9.1 Classes with four (4) or more boats will be scored as one-design classes.

9.2 Open monohull and open multihull classes will be scored if more than four boats register for each class, otherwise one open class will be scored.

9.3 Open monohull, open multihull classes, and the Bryan Cup will be scored using wind-adjusted Portsmouth handicaps.

9.4 One race is required to be completed to constitute a series.

9.5 A boat's series score shall be the total of her race scores.

10. RISK STATEMENT

10.1 RRS 3 states: 'The responsibility for a boat's decision to participate in a race or to continue to race is hers alone.' By participating in this event each competitor agrees and acknowledges that sailing is a potentially dangerous activity with inherent risks. These risks include strong winds and rough seas, sudden changes in weather, failure of equipment, boat handling errors, poor seamanship by other boats, loss of balance on an unstable platform and fatigue resulting in increased risk of injury. **Inherent in the sport of sailing is the risk of permanent, catastrophic injury or death by drowning, trauma, hypothermia or other causes.**

11. PRIZES

11.1 Trophies will be awarded based on the number of boats in a class that start at least one race.

11.2 The **Mayor's Cup** is awarded to the winner of the one design class with the highest number of boats that start in at least one race. This trophy honors the City of Greensboro and its years of support of sailing in the Piedmont.

11.3 The **Bryan Cup** is awarded to the winner with the highest average number of boats defeated per race in its start (excluding the Mayor's Cup class). This trophy honors Joseph Bryan and the Bryan family for their generosity to the City of Greensboro.
