Lake Townsend Yacht Club, Greensboro, NC and Greensboro Parks and Recreation invite you to the 2019 Mayor's Cup Regatta located on Lake Townsend. Lake Townsend is a gem of a lake with minimal motorboat traffic and a great venue for the social events that accompany the regatta. Come join the fun!

1 RULES

The Regatta will be governed by the *rules* as defined in The Racing Rules of Sailing (RRS).

2 ELIGIBILITY AND CREW

All classes of sailboats with active US Sailing Portsmouth numbers are invited to compete. All boats must have a number on their mainsail.

5 SAILING INSTRUCTIONS AND CHECK-IN

Sailing Instructions and NOR will be posted on the LTYC website by May 26, 2019 at <http://laketownsendyachtclub.com> . Copies will be available at registration. Registration and Competitors meeting will be at the Picnic Shelter #10 adjacent to the Marina. **All skippers and crew must check in at the registration table before 1015 on Saturday, June 1** to receive race materials, confirm crew, and to sign the waiver form if necessary. Waiver forms for minor skippers and crew (under 18 years of age) must be signed by a parent.

6 VENUE

Lake Townsend Marina: 6332 Townsend Rd., Brown Summit, NC 27214.

7 NUMBER OF RACES

Five (5) races are scheduled with one (1) race constituting a regatta.

8 COURSES

Courses to be sailed as described in the Sailing Instructions. **All 420 sailboats will sail one lap of any given course, regardless of the number of laps designated on the course board.**

9 SCORING

Classes with four (4) or more boats will be scored as one-design classes. Open monohull and open multihull classes will be scored if more than 4 boats register for each class. If fewer than 4 monohulls and 4 multihulls register, one open class will be scored. Open monohull and open multihull classes and Bryan Cup will be scored using wind-adjusted Portsmouth handicaps. No scores will be excluded.

10 PRIZES

Trophies will be awarded based on the number of registered boats in a class. The **Mayor's Cup** is awarded to the winner of the one design class with the highest average number of boats beaten per race in its class. This trophy honors the City of Greensboro and its over 40 years of support of sailing in the Piedmont. The **Bryan Cup** is awarded to the winner of the open class (monohull or multihull) with the highest average number of boats beaten per race in its open class. This trophy honors Joseph Bryan and the Bryan family for their generosity to the City of Greensboro.

Competitors participate in the regatta entirely at their own risk. See RRS 4, Decision to Race. The organizing authority will not accept any liability for material damage or personal injury sustained in conjunction with or prior to, during or after the regatta.
