

## Requirements

Team members are required to be either in the 8th grade or in high school; they must be competent swimmers; provide their own PFD and wetsuit for cool weather sailing; and must have completed a basic sailing course, such as LTYC's learn to sail class or equivalent. All team members are required to join LTYC as a student member and pay a nominal participation fee per semester to cover expenses and to maintain the team's equipment. Members are not required to provide their own boats!
