
## Lake Townsend Yacht Club

## **Adult Learn To Sail Classes**

Beginner and Intermediate | \$175 - Group | \$225 - Private

**Discover** the fun and excitement as you convert wind power to sail power!

**Beginner?** From knot tying to boat rigging to steering, learn the skills of sailing. Determine wind direction and sail position, then head out on the water to practice sailing on an Aqua Finn, Sunfish, Laser Pico and Capri 14.2. **Intermediate?** Classes are taught with Main and Jib sails. This class requires basic sailing skills and will teach the sailor advanced skills. This is a great follow-up to the Beginner class. Boats used in this class include Tanzer 16, Wayfarer, Lightning, Flying Scot, Capri 14, and RS-Quest.

Minimum age is 16 for Adult classes.
